The IKSDP areas surrounding the Lake Victoria and Nyandiwa peninsula (Homa Bay County, Kenya) A territory of about 500 km² with an average density of 140 inhabitants per square kilometer: the region is high level in poverty. Since 1983, volunteers and local people work together side by side successfully sharing educational and social interventions, cultural and economic, then managed independently by the local team.

Harambee in Swahili language means 'working together': it's the cry used by fishermen when, by joining forces, they pull the nets to shore. This is the spirit of the project: collaborating to plan together, establishing friendship ties without prejudice, in the interest of the community. The IKSDP aqueduct was the first intervention carried out by scout volunteers (1991-1993), to solve the serious problem of drinking water in the region: today it stretches for 20 km from the Kisaku Forest to Nyandiwa and serves about 20,000 people. Management and maintenance are entrusted to local volunteers, supported by the team of the Center.

Agriculture and breeding are very difficult by the dry seasons alternating with heavy rains. So, concrete and sustainable models are experimented, managed by cooperatives of young people and women. From the 2 chickens in 1989 to the 250 laying hens of today, the IKSDP Farm is extended with some cows, catfish and tilapia bred in larges tanks among the vegetable garden, with excellent results, even recycling the leftovers from the hens' feed.

The experimental cultivation of sunflowers began in 2014 in our Kitawa fields: after the first small productions, from 2017 the oil production is fully operational. A great success, thanks to the squeezing system donated by the 'Calabria for Harambee'. Every year we make two excellent harvests and we are currently experimenting with the cultivation of soy.

The IKSDP Teachers Training College is a great success, with growing registrations, in particular those female, now in the majority: a conquest towards gender equality! Most students graduate with excellent ratings and find work quickly. The educational offer has been extended with the degree course for Primary teachers and for ECD (Childhood Education Program). Even the technological training, with the support of Google Cloud, has been engaged for a few years by Innext and Google for Education, alongside the local IKSDP staff in the community development initiatives carried out in Nyandiwa.

The opening of the Ongombeh Stadium Sports Center has encouraged the development and organization of sporting events, involving both the community and the neighboring villages. The IKSDP Nyandiwa Sport Center focuses on gender equality and develops ethical values and personal talents in young people (about 70% of the population), exploiting sport as a means of aggregation and a meeting point for the local community.

The IKSDP Center already has an Internet Service since 2007, with the possibility of writing texts, photocopies, scanning, bookbinding. From then to Nyandiwa they opened other similar services: proving that offering replicable examples leads to a growth of the community. Today the Center's WiFi network has a 3G broadband connection spread throughout the area, thanks to Innext and Fidoka collaboration.

After receiving the secondary school diploma, it's possible to attend different levels of courses: Professional degree in Computer Studies and IT, one more academic and other specific, from Basic IT Essential to Computer Maintenance & Repair, Video Editing and Digital Photography, Web Design and Computer Programming.

The IKSDP project aims to exploit all natural and renewable resources, solar and wind: in the naturalistic site of Kitawa (17 hectares of arid land, now irrigated) sunflowers and Jatropha are cultivated, from which fuel oil is obtained for lighting and cooking (from fertilizer, waste, soap, glycerine and lubricant). In the future we intend to test its use as Biodiesel. While part of the land is cultivated with vegetables, a large area is reserved for Educational Research for the students, given the richness of the ecosystem.



The village of Nyandiwa in 40 years has gone from 300 inhabitants to about 20,000, but also holds the sad record of HIV-infected patients. The "Nyandiwa Health Center" serves the whole area and, recently, with the help of the IKSDP-Harambee project, it has a Telemedicine GHT-Light platform with the devices connected to it: now it is possible to perform free diagnoses and specialist exams, electrocardiograms, ECG and ... caesarean sections!
