Inside the Scout Centre, they have chosen to realize structures and activity of public utility: the Social Room has really become a gathering place for both local population and many groups of young people applying for to use spaces and facilities for meetings and conferences. It's furnished with the teleconferencing items for over 1000 people. The Hall is rented at Ksh.1,500 per day (about 17 \$).

The structures of IKSDP-Nyandiwa International Scout Centre are used periodically for specialized health interventions carried out by Kenyans doctors (an example is the Temporary Eye Clinic for the South Nyanza people, from November 28 to December 2, 2011).

At the dispensary Nyandiwa, addition to the normal health activities, are carried out campaigns prevention and hygiene education.



The conditions of the breeding and fishing in the Nyandiwa peninsula are always worrying and can cause serious consequences for the basic feeding of the population. The projects to increase the products available for the population are very important: the Nyandiwa IKSDP farm now includes: raising chickens, raising cows and breeding of fish. In Kitawa has been extended the vegetables cultivation between the rows of jatropha trees.

cultivation of 'jatropha curcas', suitable for cultivation in tropical and subtropical regions The collection of seeds produced by plants serve to draw an oil that can be used as alternative energy for lighting, cooking food, the production of biogas and biodiesel.



Other derivatives are soap, glycerine, candles and agricultural fertilizers. In the area has been built an irrigation system and a building for the storage and the equipment for processing of seeds. From 2011 began the production of vegetables planted between the trees of jatropha and the results are encouraging. In addition, a portion of land was reserved for an Educational Park due to its rich flora and fauna.
